### Youth Programs

- Our application to participate in Adventures in Citizenship in Ottawa has been accepted – we can send one high school student to this event. The deadline for student names is March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Kim will arrange interviews for interested students at Sussex High and Petitcodiac High. Dan and Sharon volunteered to help with interviews. If anyone else is interested, please contact Kim. Interviews will take place in mid-February.
- Youth Merit Awards is a Rotary District 7810 scholarship contest for Grade 12 students. Each high school is sent an application and asked to submit one student for these awards. The District presents the top 3 students with a prize of \$1000 for first place and \$500 each for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. A certificate is sent to all students nominated for this program, and our Club has in the past awarded a cash prize to students nominated from Sussex High or Petitcodiac High.
- Each year we award two \$1,000 scholarships to graduates of Sussex High School. We spoke about the criteria for these scholarships (the students are chosen by the high school). Keri will get a copy of the criteria used for our scholarships so we can discuss it at a future business meeting.
- Kim mentioned that there will be an open house on January 30<sup>th</sup> at P.A.L.S. to which all club members are invited

## **Membership**

Membership continues to be a key focus of our Club, however to date there seems to be a lack of support from individual club members to help our president with this very important task. Please consider what you can do as a Rotarian to help in this area.

## **Funding Request**
